Tranquil savannahs surrounded by stately old mountains are the trademarks of this family estate.

GOLF COURSE:

The 18-hole course, designed by Peter Matkovich, an accomplished designer of several South African golf courses, flows in harmony amongst the camel thorn trees and dry river beds. The course was established in 2013 and since then the greens have grown into themselves and settled into glorious surfaces with subtle breaks and undulations. The course offers a fantastic golfing experience for all levels of golfers.
